

Reviewer's checklist

Please consider the following points during your review:

- **Importance:** Is the work important? Is this the right journal for this paper?
- **Originality:** Is the work original? Does it add to the existing literature and why? If not, why not?
- **Clarity:** Is overall message, as well as the specific points, of the paper clear?
- **Scientific reliability:**
 - Abstract/summary: Does the abstract accurately reflect what the paper contains?
 - Research question: Is the research question clearly defined and appropriately answered?
 - Overall design of study: Is the design of the study adequate?
 - Participants studied: Are the participants described adequately and their conditions defined?
 - Methods: Are the methods described clearly and completely?
 - Results: Does the paper answer the research question? Is that answer credible? Are the results presented clearly?
 - Usefulness of tables and figures: Are the tables and figures presented so that the results are clearly understandable? Can some of them be eliminated? Is the data in the tables and figures correct?
 - Interpretations and conclusions: Are the interpretations and conclusions being drawn warranted from the data presented? Does the data adequately support them? Is the resulting message clear?
 - References: Are they up to date and relevant? Are there any omissions that should be included?
