

## **Conditions and Guidelines for a free-of-charge, temporary online trial access to Karger's digital publications**

### **1. Permitted Uses to the Trial Licensee and to the Trial Licensee's Authorized Users\*:**

- a) To make single print or electronic copies of single articles for personal, scholarly, educational, scientific research or internal business use, which explicitly excludes storage on an internal article database/archive
- b) To search, view, retrieve and display single articles for personal, scholarly, educational, scientific research or internal business use
- c) To make such temporary local electronic copies by means of cacheing or mirrored storage as are necessary solely to ensure efficient use
- d) To distribute a copy of individual articles or items of the Materials in print or electronic form to other Authorized Users.

### **2. Prohibited Uses:**

- a) To systematically make print or electronic copies of the Materials for any purpose. Electronic copies from Materials available for trial access can be made for storage of individual items only, not systematically, and have to be deleted after use immediately. Also backup copies are only allowed as are reasonably necessary.
- b) To mount or distribute any part of the Materials on any electronic network other than the Secure Network
- c) To integrate the Materials with any other material or otherwise create derivative works in any form and/or medium
- d) To make available to any third party who is not an Authorized User a copy of any part of the Materials either in print or electronically
- e) To remove or alter Publisher's copyright notice or any other means of identification or disclaimer as they appear in the Materials.

### **3. Written permission has to be obtained in order to:**

- a) Use the Materials commercially
- b) To distribute parts or the whole of the Materials to anyone other than to Authorized Users
- c) Publish, distribute or make available the Materials, works based on the Materials or works which combine them with any other material.

### **4. The Trial Licensee has to ensure that:**

- a) Only Authorized Users are provided with access
- b) All Authorized Users are appropriately notified to respect Publisher's intellectual property rights of the Materials and advise them of the sanctions which incur in failing to comply with copyright regulations
- c) Reasonable steps are taken to protect the Materials from unauthorized use.

\*Definition of Authorized User:

- (1) Current members of the Trial Licensee and other staff the Academic Institution
- (2) Individuals who are currently studying at the Trial Licensee's institution who are permitted to access the Secure Network from within the Library Premises or from such other places where Authorized Users work or study on campus and who have been equipped by the Trial Licensee with a password or other authentication
- (3) Other persons who are permitted to use the Trial Licensee's library or information service and access the Secure Network but only from computer terminals within the Library Premises (otherwise known as 'walk-ins').
